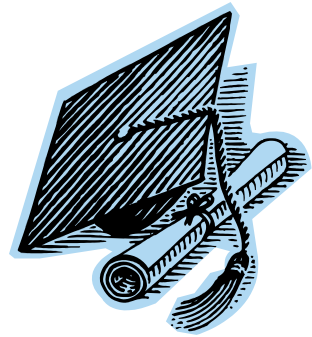

Senior Reflect and Look to Future

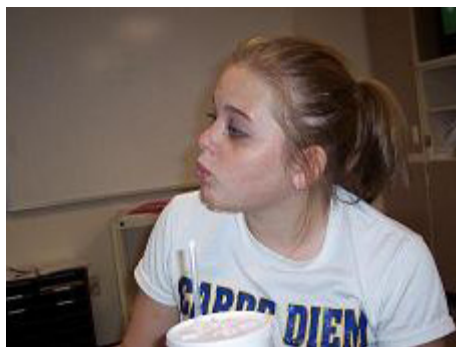

Lorena Mena is going to work all summer and move in with one of her close friends.

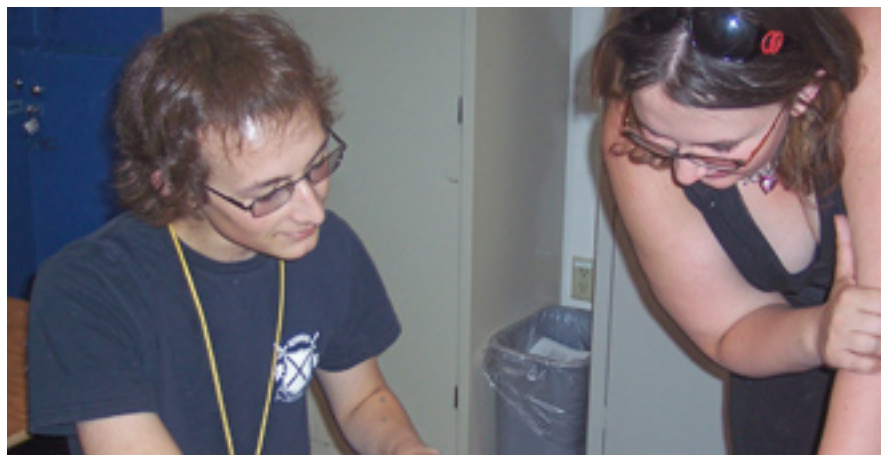
Brittany Buck is planning on moving up to Tempe to attend ASU along with boy friend, Joseph Barnette who won an Airforce Scholarship.

Yearbook Staffers Look Over This Year's Book

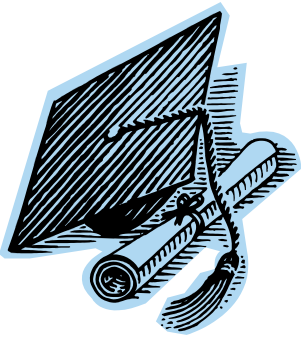


Seniors Kyle LaRose and Allana Erickson look over the yearbook before general distribution begins.

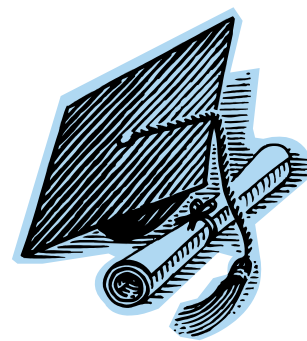
