ACT/SAT

- The next **ACT** Test date is June 13, 2009. The last date to register is May 8, 2009. Late fee registration is May 9-22. This test is given on our campus.
- The next **SAT** Test date is June 6, 2009. The last day to register without a late fee is May 5, 2009. The last day to register with a late fee is May 15. This test is given on our campus.

Summer School Information

CGUHSD will be offering summer school this summer for those students who need to make up a class due to failure or NC and students who have fallen behind their cohort in credits due to failing grades and/or NC. Students wanting to “get ahead” can see their guidance counselors regarding opportunities at CAC that may fill their academic interests.

Academic Courses are designed for students who have already taken a course and failed to meet the minimum requirements to pass the course and/or students who have fallen behind their cohort in credit earnings due to lack of success in academic courses.

Session One will be held at the Casa Verde/Desert Winds High School Campus June 1, 2009 – June 19, 2009 from 8:00 am – 12:00 pm. Students will be required to attend all 15 days of summer school.

Session Two will be held at the Casa Grande Union High School Campus June 22, 2009 – July 13, 2009 (no school July 3) from 8:00 am – 12:00 pm. Students will be required to attend all 15 days of summer school.

Courses Offered: The following courses will be offered: English 1-8, Algebra 1-4, Geometry 1-2, American History 1-2, World History/Geography 1-2, US Government, FES, Health, Scientific Inquiry 1-2. Tuition is \$25 per class.

Driver's Education will meet from May 26-June 5 for classroom learning at the Casa Grande Union High School Campus and the remainder of the requirement will be 6 hours of “behind the wheel” training that will be coordinated through the instruction during class and may extend beyond the formal summer school dates. Tuition is \$200.

Payment is due prior to the first day of the course unless payment arrangements have been made with the Summer School Administrator before the first day of classes. Fees for summer school are paid at the bookstore. **Any student dropped for attendance reasons will not receive a refund. Students who NEVER attend class are entitled to a full refund of fees paid.**

Registration: Students wanting to sign up for summer school courses should see their assigned guidance counselor at their school site.

Transportation: Bus services will not be available.

Food Service: Food Service will not be available.
